Days and Times: Monday through Thursday, July 19 - 29, 2021
8:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.

Free breakfast, lunch, and snacks will be provided daily.

Staff: Teachers are highly qualified, with experience teaching kindergarten through 2nd grade. Each school will also have a paraprofessional staff member for extra classroom support. Class sizes are expected to be 12 students per teacher.

Curriculum: Daily instruction will focus on phonics and literacy skills needed for early reading and writing. We will be providing a vocabulary-rich, balanced literacy curriculum that is developmentally appropriate for young students.
