We were happy to welcome back our students on January 7. This is a very busy time of year in our classrooms. We are preparing to take our i-Ready Diagnostic and are looking for our students to show growth in their learning from the first diagnostic. We are focused on preparing our 3rd, 4th and 5th grade students to take the Florida Standards Assessment later this spring. FSA is rigorous, demanding and requires students to think and reason their answers to show what they know. The FSA is designed to test students' mastery of the Florida Standards and what they need to know to be successful in their upcoming years of school.

Our teachers have been focused on scheduling conferences and meeting with parents to discuss students' progress. If you have not yet met with your child or children's teachers, please contact them so that they can schedule a time to meet with you at your convenience. **In April, our 4th and 5th graders will take the FSA writing assessment and 3rd grade students will take FSA reading. The remaining assessments for grades 3-5 will be administered in May.** Our 5th graders will also add Science to their assessments. Please help us by insuring that your child attends regularly and arrives on time to school. The time the tardy bell rings, the classrooms are hard at work. Students who are absent miss out on the quality instruction provided by our teachers and students who arrive late disrupt the routine of the classroom for all students.

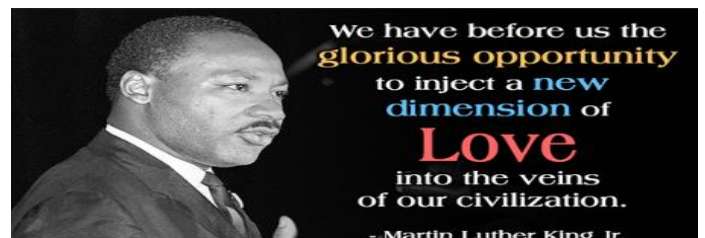
Bullying Prevention Update: Parents, we have had an influx of reports of bullying. Below is the definition of bullying from pacer.org. Please note, we are providing students with peer conflict resolution strategies to deal with bullying and other incidents. February 1, 2019 is Black Out Bullying Day. Students and staff are being asked to wear Black and White in Unity against bullying.

*"Bullying is different from the routine conflicts of childhood. It is **intentional behavior** that is meant to hurt and dominate another person. Characterized by an imbalance of power between the child who bullies and the target, bullying can be physical, verbal, emotional (social), or sexual. It includes harassment using technology, such as texts, email, and social media."*

Our January Key to Character is **RESPONSIBILITY**. Throughout the month, we will be helping students to understand what it means to be responsible by cooperating with others, persevering through hard tasks, practicing self-discipline in all areas and showing good citizenship.
