With the recent Summer-like weather lasting into early November, it does get warm during lunch. I am hoping the A/C replacement happens very soon. Also, during the winter months, new fencing will be installed to keep the campus more secure. Lake Orienta's campus will only be accessible through the front office located in building 1. Building 2, Building 6, the PE pavilion, Building 3, and Building 5 that house Hopper Center will all be behind a locked security gate. This improvement was a decision made by the School Board with guidance from the Seminole County Sheriff's office. We will be adding a covered walkway to connect Buildings 1 and 2 to allow transitions between the buildings using the quickest route.
